Why Get a Permit?

Building permits are safeguards to ensure that construction projects performed on private property are safe, meet environmental standards and comply with adopted building codes. These safeguards protect homeowners and their family, friends and neighbors from work that does not meet minimum code requirements. Building permits help protect an owner's financial investment and minimize liability or problems during a future sale of the real estate.

Please contact Woodson Terrace for zoning approval before reaching out to St. Louis County. Woodson Terrace requires a site plan depicting the following information before zoning approval is granted:

- 1. Location and dimensions of any existing structures and their distance from the property lines;
- 2. The direction of the slope or drainage is illustrated on the site plan by arrows;
- 3. The ground elevations and the elevation of the top of the foundation of the structure(s);
- 4. Location and width of easements (Easements give access rights to Utility Companies and other dulyauthorized agencies), thus building within a dedicated easement is restricted;

Homeowners drawing their own construction plans may obtain a copy of their site plan from:

- 1. The survey of your house at the time you purchased the property;
- 2. The Title Company that closed the sale of your house;
- 3. The building permit for your house;
- 4. The St. Louis County, Assessor's Plat Book maps

BUILDING PERMIT SPECS

FENCING

Foremost must adhere to ORD. # 1857, Sec. 400.260.

GENERAL

Max 6' in height.

Fence bottom 1-2" above ground to facilitate grass trimming

Good side out—horizontal and vertical support members inside of fenced area or hidden from both neighbors' and general public's view.

Post holes 30" deep minimum.

Chain link sharps edge down.

Proper fasteners, no sharps protruding on privacy fence.

FLATWORK

6 sack fiber mix. 4" slump- air-entrained- if freezing temps possible.

Compacted subsoil or compacted 4" rock base.

Isolate at foundations and sidewalks.

Expansion joints every 10'.

Approach 6" thick 10' long.

SHEDS/GARAGE

If the shed is less than 120 sq. ft. fill out STORAGE SHED REGISTRATION form at City Hall.

If the shed is larger than 120 sq. ft. it must be on a mono slab or pier system, and a permit from the City of Woodson Terrace is required.

Garages—need foundation system and St. Louis County permitting.
