MAIN REPORT	The New Town Hall sign is finished and installed. The white post design compliments the white railing in front of the building. More railings will be added in the future.
	The computer system for City Hall and Police Department is in dire need of replacement. CDS Technologies came out and did an assessment for free, where most companies were charging thousands of dollars for the service.
	The phone system is also in the process of being updated. The City chose to go with a Mitel Cloud based phone system, making repairs and tweaks much easier. This will eliminate billing errors and confusion we've experienced with ATT, and come in at a lower monthly cost.
	Public Works is ready for weather events, should they come our way.
	Public Works will be budgeting for a new zero turn mower in 2018. The one they have has logged many hours and they want to trade it in before it has no value.
	The open code enforcement position has transitioned to full time, experienced code enforcer.
	We are in the beginning stages of surverying and other necessary procedures needed to establish a comprehensive Sidewalk Repair Action Plan to satisfy the ADA Requirements for sidewalks, ramps and crosswalks.
