City Administrator Doug Zaiz reported the following:

MAIN REPORT

Public Works routinely takes the summer months off chipping. They will be chipping once per month, the next time being September 17. Residents can still use yard waste services. Chipping will resume on a weekly basis October 1st.

We have had issues with bulk items left at the curb. Bulk items are picked up, 2 per household, on the last scheduled pick up day of the month. You must call Republic to schedule these pick ups. If items are found during the beginning of the month, they are tagged and cited if not removed.

This current week is the last full time week at the pool. The remaining hours between now and Sept 6 will be 11-5pm.

Alderman Hogan asked when the contract with Republic was up. Doug Zaiz & Ellie Crane conferred and believe it is Oobter of 2021. Doug Zaiz states they are ready to go out for bid.

Alderman Mills shares that some adjoining towns do not have recycle service at all, and he appreciates that we do still receive that service. Doug Zaiz briefly explained the recycle issues. China used to buy it all, but now will only purchase 5% contaminated, which is virtually impossible to do. Broken glass, dirty cardboard, all can ruin a load.

Alderman Welby asked Code enforcement to please check on 9513 Harold & 9440 Harold for grass & trash violations.

These will get passed on to Code.

Alderman Mills also noted the Sign at A! Liquor and Tobacco is listing. Possibly from the recent storms. Perhaps they haven't noticed, and could we notify them.

Doug Zaiz will have Code check on that, also.

With nothing further, the meeting adjourned at 6:55pm.
