City Administrator Doug Zaiz reported the following:

MAIN REPORT

Saint Louis County Health is allowing pools to open this summer. With this in mind the pool will be ready 5/1 for lifeguard training.

The City will have camp, but it will be limited to 40 campers this year to allow for social distancing. According to St. Louis County, they will be able to swim and do field trips.

The Pool is looking for guards. Send people to City Hall to fill out an application.

Per DOH, Pavilions are still at 50% so that is something we could consider. We will also check if we can open the public restrooms down at the park.

There have been complaints about Ameren cutting down trees, but they were putting up new poles and we can plant some lower vegetation. Doug Zaiz explained that these areas are RIGHT of WAYS meant to give utilities and government entities room to work on infrastructure.

Trashcans were delivered this week; City Hall received many calls about this. City Administrator Doug Zaiz explained we had prepared a mailing, but the mail isn't always delivered these days.
