SUBJECT: Notification to Civilian Governing Body and Local Community

On May 25, 2022, Presidential Executive Order (EO) 14074 “Advancing Effective, Accountable Policing and Criminal Justice Practices to Enhance Public Trust and Public Safety” was signed.

In accordance with EO 14074 (Section 12), State, Tribal, local, and Territorial Law Enforcement agencies (LEAs) must:

- 1) Notify their Civilian Governing Body (CGB) (*i.e.*, *City Council, County Government or other local governing body*) of its intent to request property from Federal sources (to include Federal funds or grants).
- 2) Notify the Local Community of its request for property transfers, purchases from Federal funds, agencies or subcontractors (including existing transfer contracts or grants).

The Woodson Terrace Police Department may request the below controlled property items from the Law Enforcement Support Office (LESO), or other Federal source:

Controlled Property Description
ATV, blankets, breathing apparatus, camera system, containers, gas detector, facemask,
decontamination devices/system, flashlights, floodlight, breaching apparatus, riot helmets
forward looking infrared imaging system, generator set, heavy equipment/vehicles, marksmanship
Trainer, medical/first aid supplies, misc. small arms parts, misc. communications equipment, night
vision device/goggle, office equipment, office supplies, portable radio, protective eyewear, public
Address set, radios, red dot sight, rifle scope, shield (ballistic), sight (holographic), sight (reflex),
small arms storage rack, spotting instrument (optical), target (training/mobile), tents/portable shelters,
Thermal camera, thermal camera accessories, training aid/simulators, training aides/devices, translation
device, truck (cargo), armored vehicles wheeled, small arms, ammunition container, binocular,
conversion kit (rifle), non-armored HMMWV, marker (identification), GPS, vehicle repair parts/
components, insulation blanket, coveralls, riot/crowd control batons, vehicles (all),
Container (K9 transport), shipping container, telescope, multimedia projection set, magnifier,
scanner (Xray/baggage), ballistic blanket, unmanned aerial vehicles, warm weather clothing/shoes
prefab & portable buildings, barrier/vehicle arresting/portable, range finder /laser,
Explosive ordinance disposal robot, antenna, armored vehicle, container/ammunition, searchlight
Computer system, analyzer (hazardous materials identification), riot/crowd control shields, specialized
Firearms and ammunition under .50 caliber, command and control vehicles, tactical vehicles wheeled,
small arms parts/accessories.
