**APPROVAL OF
MINUTES**

Following a motion from Alderman Joan Willey, seconded by Alderman Donna Conlon; the Board unanimously approved minutes from June's Public Works Meeting.

The following items were discussed,

MAIN REPORT

Deputy Director of Public works Doug Hill said the committee at the Finance Meeting on July 11th approved to recommend to the Board the approval to purchase 3 new White Ford Trucks, Snow plows and salt spreaders. The Mayor told everyone that our current trucks are ageing and in rough shape and most are from 2010, so the trucks and equipment are necessary.

Doug Hill announced that this year to date the code enforcement has 404 cases. 115 are closed and there are 289 cases that are still active in various states.

As a result of the resent traffic study and a meeting with the city administrator Doug Zaiz No Parking Signs have been ordered and the projected installation will be by the end of the month.

Alderman Joan Willey asked when the fence at the park would be fixed and Doug Hill said it was scheduled for August 6th.

Alderman Joan Willey Also asked about the tires by the fields, asked why they were there and if we could get rid of them. City Administrator Doug Zaiz said they were from the Rugby team that practices up there and he will call them to see if they can come and remove them.
