MAIN REPORT

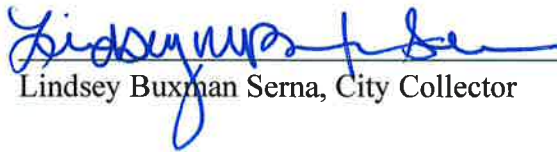
