APPROVAL OF MINUTES

**POLICE DEPARTMENT –
2026 vehicles**

Chief Bret Carbray presented to the Board a request to purchase 2 vehicles for the police department. The first one is a 2025 Ford police interceptor. Total from the Police capital fund would be \$41,820.00 and from the General fund \$7,353.00. The second vehicle is a 2026 Ford Explorer. The total from either the Police capital fund or a federal grant fund would be \$45,000 and \$4,555 from general funds.

Alderman Mills asked for a motion to approve the total of \$98,728.00 for the purchase of 2 police vehicles this year. Alderman Zaiz made the motion, seconded by Alderman Belford. With an all on favor motion carried.
