BILL 2222: POLICE RADIO CONTRACT WITH ST. LOUIS COUNTY

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND RENEWING AN AGREEMENT WITH ST. LOUIS COUNTY, MISSOURI, ACTING FOR THE ST. LOUIS COUNTY EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS COMMISSION RELATING TO INTEROPERABLE RADIO SYSTEMS
