BILL 2236 ADOPTING THE BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1ST 2025 – JUNE 30TH 2026

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF WOODSON TERRACE FOR THE FISCAL YEAR COMMENCING JULY 1, 2025, AND ENDING JUNE 30, 2026, MAKING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE EXPENDITURES PROVIDED FOR IN SAID BUDGET.
