**MODOT HIGHWAY
SAFETY & TRAFFIC
GRANT**

Director of Public Works Doug Hill advised the committee that MoDot has a grant program that would allow the city to purchase 11 solar-powered flashing LED stop signs and 11 solar-powered radar speed signs. The only thing that would cost the city is \$5,800 to cover the fee of TMZ marketing services to submit the grant. All items would be purchased after the grant was awarded.

Chairman Mills made a motion to recommend to the Board approval of the MoDot safety & traffic grant. With an all in favor Motion carried.

**GRANT FOR BODY
WORN CAMERAS FOR
POLICE DEPT.**

Interim Police Chief Bret Carbray advised the Committee they were interested in applying for a grant for body worn cameras. No purchase would be made until grant was awarded. And the grant would be for \$34,000. The only cost to the city is \$5,800 for TMZ marketing services to submit the grant.

Chairman Mills made a motion to recommend to the Board approval of the body worn camera grant. With a all in favor motion carried.
