APPROVAL OF MINUTES FEBRUARY 12, 2026

Chairman Mills asked for a motion to approve the minutes from the February 13, 2026, meeting. Alderman Martin made the motion, seconded by Alderman Zaiz. With a unanimous decision motion passed.

POLICE DEPARTMENT

Chief Carbray presented a P.D. request for new office furniture for the Chief's office and the Major's office, at a cost of \$4,749.62, with the funds coming out of the Prop P account. After a short discussion Chairman Mills entertained a motion to recommend to the Board approval to spend \$4,749.62 for the purchase of the furniture. Alderman Martin made the motion, seconded by Alderman Zaiz. With all in favor motion carried.

OFFICE STAFF
PAY ADJUSTMENT**

Mayor Besmer introduced bill 2249 with proposed changes to ordinance 2070 regarding adjustments to the compensation of City Clerk, Finance Manager, Court Administrator, Deputy Court Clerk, and City Collector. After some discussion it was determined that the board members need to see the current ordinance 2070 to see the changes proposed. Alderman Martin entertained a motion to recommend to the Board approval of the new ordinance 2091 pending evaluating the adjustments being made from the current ordinance 2070. Alderman Stewart made the motion, seconded by Alderman Martin. With all in favor the motion carried.

**PUBLIC WORKS/PARKS
SWIMMING POOL PUMP**

After some review and discussion of a Proposal from The Pump Shop to repair the City's swimming pool pump at a cost of \$15,755.00 or replace the existing swimming pool pump at a cost of \$22,464.00, Chairman Mills requested a motion to pass this information to the entire Board so the decision can be made at the March 19th, 2026 Board Meeting. Alderman Martin made the motion, seconded by Alderman Zaiz. With all in favor the motion carried.

With nothing further Chairman Mills called for a motion to Adjourn, Alderman Martin made the motion seconded by Alderman Zaiz. With a unanimous vote the meeting ended at 7:11 p.m.
