APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Chairman Zaiz entertained a motion to approve the minutes from the October 16th, 2025, meeting. Alderman Mills made the motion, seconded by Alderman Willey. The Board unanimously approved minutes from October's Public Works Meeting.

The following items were discussed,

MAIN REPORT

Director of Public Works Doug Hill informed the Board that there is a street access snow removal program he found from another municipality for the 2026-2027 calendar year he is working on creating a similar program for our city.

Possible change to the Ordinance 355.140 to remove the declaration of a snow emergency and adding no street parking when snow exceeds 2". Street signs would also be posted under the stop signs. Section B of this ordinance currently enforces towing at the police chief or public works director discretion.

Public Works is working on Christmas decoration for City Hall and the Park.

Doug Hill is also looking into LED flashing solar powered flashing stop signs. The same ones that Edmundson currently has. He advised he is looking into grants to help offset the cost of these.
