MAIN REPORT

Deputy Director of Public works Doug Hill let everyone know that the Town Hall has been completed. The next steps will be tuck pointing and possibly new windows. At that point the building will be water proof. Throughout the winter Public Works will do the needed work on the inside.

The swimming pool is leaking. The water level dropped 18 inches. Work will be done in mid-June to find the leak, then repair after next pool season. Decisions are still being determined.

A bucket truck is pending approval at the Board meeting, if purchased will be used to trim trees and change out the light banners.

The water main break at Harold and Herbert was poorly patched. The water company will come back mid December to properly repair the street.

The Strip with Dollar General is making slow progress on the work being done, but they are working.

Timberlake Apartments is making big progress and improving the buildings. They are complying with all the permits. A lot of Occupancy inspections have passed in the past few weeks. There are still some Fire safety issues but are being addressed.
